AHI Connects: Meet the People

Enjoy an authentic Druze lunch when a family welcomes you into their home. The Druze cuisine is characterized by special blends of delectable, tasty spices.

AHI Connects: Shabbat. Experience an authentic Shabbat tonight with a local family in their home. Learn about key concepts of the weekly observance and share challah, a delicious traditional bread.

Tel Aviv's Ancient Port of Jaffa, Explore the port of Old Jaffa, and visit a market and an artist's studio. Walk through the artsy Neve Tzedek area and visit the Center for Israeli Innovation, which celebrates the country's achievements in agriculture, medicine, transportation and more.

White City of Tel Aviv. Admire the beauty, Bauhaus-style buildings and limestone architecture of "The White City."

Mediterranean Coast. See Caesarea's Roman ruins, including Herod's massive amphitheater, hippodrome and aqueduct, followed by a multimedia presentation.

Ancient Akko. Stop at Akko, the most complete and well-preserved town in the Holy Land, and visit the Crusader fort.

Upper Galilee. Cruise on the Sea of Galilee. Visit Tabgha, a fishing village, and witness the Mount of Beatitudes.

Capernaum. Step inside the historical Ancient Synagogue and House of Peter.

Golan Heights Winery. Treat your palate to Israel's light and delicious wines.

Focus on Archeology. Stand atop layer upon layer of human occupation at Tel Megiddo's UNESCO status ruins.

Jerusalem's Open Air Market. Browse a bustling kaleidoscope of alleys, stalls, colors and flavors at the Machane Yehuda Market.

Jerusalem. Tour Old Jerusalem, including the Mount of Olives, the Western Wall and the interpretive Davidson Center. See Temple Mount, believed to be the site of the Temple of Jerusalem, the holiest place in Judaism.

A Poignant Monument. Yad Vashem is Israel's memorial for the millions who perished in the Holocaust. Carved out of the hillside, the sprawling complex has 10 exhibition halls, each dedicated to a different chapter of the Holocaust. Tour the halls and galleries and see the Hall of Names.

Masada. Join a guided tour to see the fortifications of Herod the Great atop this isolated rock plateau above the Dead Sea.

A Sea of Salt. Descend below sea level to Ein Bokek on the Dead Sea.
